

Traffic snapshot

- Total MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) registered 6.3% growth for May 2017 with 10.6million passenger movements.
- International passengers registered a 12.6% growth with 4.8million passengers in May, while domestic passengers grew by 1.5% registering 5.8million passengers.
- On a twelve month basis, 122.9million passengers recorded is the highest for the MAHB network.
- Malaysia passenger traffic grew by 8.5% in May 2017. International traffic grew by 15.2% while domestic grew by 2.4%.
- ASEAN and non-ASEAN traffic registered growth of 7.3% and 23.7% respectively in May 2017.
- KLIA Main Terminal and klia2 recorded growth of 12.7% and 11.6% respectively over May 2016 passenger numbers.
- Istanbul SGIA posted a marginal growth of 0.3% in total passenger traffic. International traffic grew by 1.9% while domestic traffic contracted by 0.5%.

Traffic performance for Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad's (MAHB) network of airports

MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) recorded 10.6million passengers in May 2017, a 6.3% growth over May 2016. International traffic recorded 4.8million passengers with a year-on-year increase of 12.6% while domestic traffic improved by 1.5% recording 5.8million passengers compared to the same period a year ago. Overall aircraft movements increased by 0.7% with international movements registering an increase of 4.8% while domestic decreased by 1.6% over May 2016. On a last-twelve-month basis, the total MAHB network of airports registered 7.1% growth with 122.9million passengers, the highest traffic handled over a 12 month period by the network.

On the local front, airports in Malaysia registered 7.9million passengers in May 2017, an 8.5% year-on-year growth over May 2016. International sector recorded 4.0million passengers with a 15.2% increase while domestic sector recorded 3.9million passengers, representing a growth of 2.4%. International traffic for ASEAN destinations grew 7.3% to 1.9million passengers whereas non-ASEAN traffic posted a 23.7% growth to 2.1million passengers. Overall aircraft movements increased by 3.3%. International aircraft movements grew by 8.8% while domestic aircraft movements increased by 0.1% over May 2016. Overall average load factors improved to 75.1% in May 2017, an increase of 1.5 percentage points compared with the same month last year.

KLIA passenger movements recorded a 12.1% increase over May 2016 with 4.8million passenger movements. A total of 1.6million passengers were recorded for the ASEAN destinations with an 11.3% growth while 1.8million passengers were recorded for the non-ASEAN destinations (20.4% growth). 1.4million passengers were recorded for domestic sector representing a growth of 3.5%. May traffic for KLIA Main Terminal grew by 12.7% while traffic for klia2 increased by 11.6%. Overall aircraft movements at KLIA increased by 8.8% over the same month last year. International aircraft movements at KLIA registered an increase of 10.0% while domestic aircraft movements registered a growth of 6.2%. The last-twelve-month passenger traffic for KLIA Main Terminal recorded 27.9million passengers which is an increase of 26.5% while klia2 improved by 0.1% with 27.7million over the corresponding period last year.

Passenger movements at MASB Airports grew by 3.3% year-on-year over May 2016 to 3.1million passenger movements in May 2017. International passenger movements increased by 10.9% recording 0.5million passengers. ASEAN traffic declined by 10.8% to 0.3million passengers while non-ASEAN traffic improved by 54.0% with 0.3million passengers. Domestic traffic grew by 1.9% to 2.6million passengers in May 2017. Aircraft movements in May 2017 declined by 0.9%, mainly contributed by domestic movements that contracted by 1.6%. International aircraft movements registered a growth of 3.9% over May 2016.

Istanbul SGIA passengers grew by 0.3% in May 2017 over the same period last year to 2.7million passengers. International passengers increased by 1.9% to 0.9million passengers while domestic decreased by 0.5% to 1.8million passengers. The growth was achieved despite a decline of 8.3% in total aircraft movements, with both international and domestic aircraft movements recording 9.3% and 7.7% decline respectively.

Overview of traffic

Passenger traffic growth was registered at 11 of 21 international and domestic airports in Malaysia with 4 airports posting double-digit growth. All regions with the exception of Africa and the Middle East registered positive growth in passenger traffic for May 2017 with Europe, North East Asia and South West Pacific growing by more than 20%. Passenger traffic to and from 9 countries recorded more than 20% growth including Maldives, Laos, Ethiopia, United Kingdom, Australia, Iran, South Korea, Sri Lanka and Taiwan. 18 airlines registered double-digit growth for international passenger traffic. They include AirAsia X, All Nippon Airways, Malindo Air, Saudi Arabian Airlines, Xiamen Airlines and Malaysia Airlines Berhad among others. The modest growth in domestic passenger movements was mainly contributed by Malindo Air offsetting the reduction posted by Firefly and Malaysia Airlines.
