

Traffic Snapshot

- In August 2024, the MAHB network of airports recorded 12 million passengers for the second consecutive month marking a 9.8% increase over August 2023 and reaching 96.1% of 2019 August levels.
- International passenger movements remained robust, with 6.5 million passengers recording an
 increase of 18.5% growth over August 2023 and exceeding pre-pandemic levels at 6.1%. The
 surge in passengers was largely driven by the summer travel, new airlines, airlines expansion to
 new routes, and additional weekly frequencies.
- Domestic passenger movements registered 5.8 million passengers, marking an 1.6% increase over August 2023, with a recovery rate of 87.1% over 2019 levels.
- Airports in Malaysia continue to surpass 8.0 million passengers for the second consecutive month, recording 4.4 million and 4.0 million for international and domestic passengers and reaching 95.2% and 84.9% of August 2019 levels respectively.
- Istanbul SGIA's total passenger movements remain credible, registering 3.9 million passengers in August 2024, recording an increase of 3.7% over August 2023. International and domestic passenger movements recorded 2.0 million passengers and 1.8 million passengers respectively, driven by summer travel holidays and airline expansions to new routes.

Overview of Traffic

Passenger movements for the MAHB network of airports recorded 12.3 million passengers, sustaining more than 12 million passengers for two consecutive months with a growth of 9.8% over August 2023, reaching 96.1% of 2019 levels. Total international passenger movements showed strong growth, recording 6.5 million passengers, recording double-digit growth of 18.5% over August 2023. The credible growth was largely driven by summer travel holidays, new airlines, airline expansion to new routes, and additional weekly frequencies. Correspondingly, domestic passenger movements sustained traffic momentum, recording 5.8 million passengers reaching 87.1% of August 2019 passenger levels.

On the local front, airports in Malaysia continued to surpass 8.0 million passengers for the second consecutive month, with an equal mix of 50:50 between international and domestic traffic. The growth was driven by additional flight frequencies and operation of new airlines and routes mainly to and from international sectors. Key international markets, particularly Indonesia, China, and India, were the top performers contributing to the increase in August traffic. Batik Air Malaysia introduced KL International Airport (KUL) to Surabaya with 14 weekly flights, and to Pekanbaru and Padang with daily flights each. Additionally, Super Air Jet began daily flights to Banda Aceh, Malaysia Airlines introduced twiceweekly flights to Balikpapan, Indonesia AirAsia added thrice weekly flights to Denpasar via Kota Kinabalu Airport, and Transnusa started daily flights to Jakarta from Subang Airport. AirAsia Cambodia and Nine Air, commenced daily flights to Phnom Penh and a once-a-week flight to Guiyang respectively. Shanghai Airlines introduced thrice weekly flights to Pudong via Penang Airport, and AirAsia launched thrice weekly flights to Ningbo from KL International Airport (KUL) and Kota Kinabalu Airport, respectively. AirAsia launched daily flights to Kozhikode and six weekly flights to Guwahati, Malaysia Airlines started daily flights to the Maldives and Chiang Mai, and AirAsia X commenced twice weekly flights to Medina. Malaysia Airlines increased its frequency from KUL to Amritsar from four weekly flights to daily flights, and AirAsia X doubled its weekly flights to Osaka Kansai.

Domestic passenger movements sustained the 4.0 million marks, increasing by 2.3% over August 2023 and reaching 84.9% of 2019 levels. The growth in domestic passenger movements was supported by Subang Airport's jet operations with the launch of new services by AirAsia and Firefly to Kota Kinabalu with 14 and 7 weekly flights, respectively, AirAsia to Kuching with 14 weekly flights, and Batik Air Malaysia to Penang with daily flights.

Istanbul SGIA recorded 3.9 million passenger movements in August 2024, marking a 3.7% increase over August 2023 and exceeding 2019 levels with a double-digit growth at 12.5%. International passenger movements recorded 2.1 million passengers, with a 7.3% growth over August 2023, and exceeding 2019 levels at a credible growth of 40.5%. The international traffic was mainly driven by Pegasus and Ajet Airlines' new services to international routes with once-a-week flights to Tuzla and five weekly flights to Cairo, respectively. Domestic passenger movements registered 1.9 million, reaching 92.2% of pre-pandemic levels from 2019.
