

Traffic snapshot

- Total MAHB network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) registered a growth of 5.3% for July 2019 over July 2018 with 12.5million passenger movements. This the highest passenger volume handled by the network of airport and the second consecutive month to surpass the 12million mark.
- International and domestic passenger movements registered 6.0million and 6.5million passengers with a growth of 5.3% respectively.
- On a twelve-month basis, MAHB network of airports recorded 136.7million passenger movements, the highest to-date.
- Malaysia passenger movements grew by 7.2% in July 2019. International and domestic passenger movements increased by 2.3% and 12.9% respectively. July 2019 international passenger movements recorded is the highest traffic for a month to-date excluding December 2018.
- Istanbul SGIA international passenger movements grew by 17.1%.

Traffic performance for Malaysia Airports Holdings Berhad's (MAHB) network of airports

MAHB's network of airports (including Istanbul SGIA) recorded 12.5million passenger movements in July 2019, an increase of 5.3% over July 2018. International sector recorded 6.0million passenger movements with a year-on-year growth of 5.3% while domestic sector grew by 5.3% compared to the same period in 2018, recording 6.5million passengers. On a last-twelve-month basis, the total MAHB network of airports registered 3.7% growth with 136.7million passengers. Overall aircraft movements increased by 3.7% with international movements registering an increase of 4.4% while the domestic movements increased by 3.3% over July 2018.

Airports in Malaysia registered 9.2million passengers in July 2019, an increase of 7.2% year-on-year growth over July 2018. International sector recorded 4.7million passengers with a growth of 2.3% while domestic sector increased by 12.9% with 4.5million passengers. International passenger movements for ASEAN destinations grew by 1.5% to 2.3million whereas non-ASEAN passenger movements recorded a growth of 3.0% with 2.4million passengers. Overall aircraft movements increased by 4.9% over July 2018 with an average load factor of 76.2%. International and domestic aircraft movements grew by 1.3% and 7.4% respectively.

KLIA passenger movements registered a 3.9% growth over July 2018 with 5.5million passenger movements. A total of 1.9million passengers were recorded for the ASEAN destinations while 2.1million passengers were recorded for the non-ASEAN destinations. Domestic sector grew by 9.6% with 1.5million passengers. The last-twelve-month passenger movements for KLIA Main Terminal recorded 28.3million passengers, an increase of 0.4%. klia2 passenger movements increased by 2.3% with 32.5million passengers. Overall aircraft movements at KLIA increased by 3.4% over the same month last year. International aircraft movements at KLIA increased by 0.7% while domestic aircraft movements registered a growth of 9.5%.

Passenger movements at MASB Airports increased by 12.4% in July 2019 over July 2018 with 3.7million passengers. International passenger movements increased by 4.5% to 0.7million passengers. ASEAN passenger movements increased by 0.4% to 0.4million passengers while non-ASEAN traffic increased by 10.7% with 0.3million passengers. Domestic passenger movements increased by 14.6% with 3.0million passengers in July 2019. Aircraft movements in July 2019 increased by 6.3%. International and domestic aircraft movements registered a growth of 3.7% and 6.8% over July 2018.

Istanbul SGIA passengers grew by 0.4% in July 2019 over the same period last year to 3.3million passengers. International passengers increased by 17.1% to 1.4million passengers while domestic decreased by 8.7% to 2.0million passengers. Total aircraft movements decreased by 0.4%.

International aircraft movements recorded 15.6% growth while domestic aircraft movements declined by 10.2% over July 2018.

Overview of traffic

MAHB network of airports recorded the highest passenger movements for a month's traffic for both the international and domestic sectors in July 2019. The traffic surpassed December passenger movements of previous years where December had always been the highest month for passenger movements. The 5.3% overall growth was contributed mainly by the high growth in Malaysia's domestic passenger movements and high growth in international passenger movements for Istanbul SGIA.

All airports in Malaysia registered growth in total passenger movements with fourteen airports recording double-digit growth for July 2019. International passenger movements for the same period also recorded the highest traffic for a month excluding December 2018. All regions recorded growth except for South Asia. There was a decrease in movements to Nepal, Sri Lanka, Maldives, Bangladesh and Pakistan. India movements however, increased by 15.2%. Higher international passenger movements was recorded for India, China, Korea, Singapore, Indonesia, Vietnam, UAE, Australia, Brunei and Saudi Arabia sectors. This increase was partly contributed by the Hajj movements, new operations by Air Arabia and additional frequencies and routes by AirAsia, Malaysia Airlines Berhad, Malindo Air, Indigo Airlines, Saudi Arabian and Jeju Air. The domestic passenger movements recorded one of the highest passenger volumes for a month. There was significant increase in traffic between KLIA and Johor Bahru, Kota Bharu, Kuching, Kuala Terengganu, Kuantan and Penang.

Istanbul SGIA achieved a record performance in international passenger movements contributed by new airlines, new frequencies and additional frequencies. Salam Air commenced 2 weekly flights from Muscat while Air Arabia Maroc commenced operations from Tangier. Meanwhile, Pegasus Airlines also commenced new operations to Manchester, Venice and Casablanca.
